INTRODUCTION

Since 1977, Kenai Riverside Lodge has been guiding guests on fishing trips down the world-famous Kenai River. Possessing limited entry permits that let you fish the premium waters of the upper Kenai River, you can try for sockeye, silver or king salmon alongside rainbow trout, Dolly Varden or halibut in Resurrection Bay. On this trip, you'll enjoy three days of guided fishing and transfers between the lodge and Anchorage.

While at Kenai Riverside Lodge, enjoy amenities like cabins outfitted with a private bath and porch, expansive riverside deck, wood-fired sauna and hearty Alaskan meals.

DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1 Anchorage to Kenai Riverside Lodge

Meet your Alaska Wildland Adventures representative this afternoon at either your downtown hotel or the Anchorage Airport. A shuttle will then take you along Turnagain Arm to Cooper Landing where you can settle into your cabin at Kenai Riverside Lodge, enjoy dinner and discuss your upcoming activities. If you're driving yourself, feel free to arrive any time between 3:00pm and 6:30pm in order to get checked in before dinner which is served at 7:15pm.

Day 2-4 Kenai Riverside Lodge | Guided Fishing

Wake up and enjoy a hearty breakfast this morning, then enjoy a full day of guided fishing on the world-famous Kenai River. The boats hold up to 4 people, so there's a possibility you will be sharing space with 3 other fishing guests. Packed lunch will be provided to enjoy on the boat, while dinner will be served back at the lodge.

Day 5 Kenai Riverside Lodge to Anchorage

Bid farewell to Kenai Riverside Lodge after breakfast and enjoy comfortable transportation back to Anchorage, arriving by noon. For those self-driving, check-out is by 10:00am.

Fishing Season

- Chinook (King) Salmon: May - July | Peak in July
- Sockeye Salmon: June - August | Peak in June - July
- Coho (Silver) Salmon: Mid July - Sept | Peak in August
- Rainbow Trout: All season | Peak in September
- Dolly Varden: All season | Peak in September
- Alaska Halibut: May - September

Kenai Riverside Lodge

At Kenai Riverside Lodge, sixteen log cabins sit among the trees that surround the main lodge building. In accord with the natural riverside setting, each of the cabins exhibits the rustic charm of a historical Alaskan pioneer cabin, only with the addition of a few modern-day comforts like heat, electricity, private baths, comfy beds and porches with outdoor seating. As part of the shared lodge facilities, guests can enjoy meals and drinks in the dining room and lounge or make use of the fire pit and sauna.

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INCLUDED

Package includes:

- 4 night accommodation in a private cabin
- Guided fishing (by boat or land)
- 3 full days (6-8 hrs each day)
- Use of lodge equipment (volleyball, badminton, horseshoes, basket ball, and ping pong)
- Use of lodge facilities (bonfire pit, evening programs, wood-fired sauna, and self-guided nature paths)
- Transportation to/from Anchorage hotel or airport
- All meals (served as family style)
- All gear (rods, reels, tackle, waders, etc.)
- Fish processing/vacuum packing and boxing

Not included

- Gratuities (recommended \$25 - \$35 per person, per day)
- Alcohol
- Fishing license (purchase online prior to arrival)
- Shipping of fish
- Fishing in Resurrection Bay (additional fee)

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
