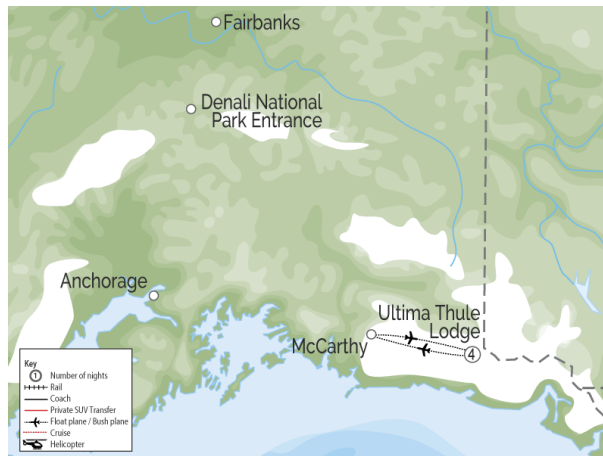

Day 1 McCarthy to Ultima Thule | Flight
